Dear Parents

Y2 Residential Visit to Burwardsley Outdoor Centre

We have arranged for Year 2 to stay at a small primary school outdoor centre in the heart of the Cheshire Countryside on the 12th March 2018. Mrs Shawcross, Miss Johnson and other staff members of the school will be attending this trip.

The plan is to leave school promptly on Monday morning and arrive at the centre to take part in an outdoor activity followed by a short walk before dinner. We will then sleep overnight at the centre. On the Tuesday morning after breakfast we will visit the Candle Factory. We will have lunch at the centre on Tuesday and then we will pack up ready to return home. We have arranged to leave the centre at 2.00 p.m. and should arrive back at school around 3.00 p.m.

The trip will cost approximately £80 but this may vary slightly according to the number of children going. If you would like your child to take part please return the slip below with a £20 deposit.

These items are suggestions for the stay.

Please label as many items as you possibly can as we always have a bag of lost property left over.

- Pyjamas and dressing gown
- Slippers or similar footwear to be worn indoors only
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Soap and flannel
- Hairbrush / comb
- Hand towel
- Tissues
- Teddy or soft toy (named)
- Small game/ activity book (not expensive electronic games)
- Two complete changes of clothing in addition to the clothes they travel in
(one for Saturday and another in case of wet weather as the children will get very muddy if it rains. For this reason please don't send brand new clothes)
- Two sets of underwear and socks for the same reason

- Spare pair of shoes or trainers in case one pair gets wet
