### Each child requires:



- Bedding will be provided by PGL!
- One bag (suitcase/holdall with wheels) clearly labelled with child's name.
- M A large plastic bag for dirty washing.
- Small plastic bag for placing dry clothes in prior to wet activities.
- Rucksack
- All belongings to be clearly labelled. Drying room is a great black hole!

### Contents of suitcase/holdall

- Old clothes, which can be discarded upon return, including old trainers.
- Several pairs of long legged trousers joggers ideal- full t-shirts only please for activities!
- Adhere to kit list definitely need warm layers for evening entertainments.
- Towels identify with your child which for use after activities and which for showering!
- Name anything you want returned!
- A 'bin bag' clearly labelled with child's name and 'Wet/dirty clothes'.
