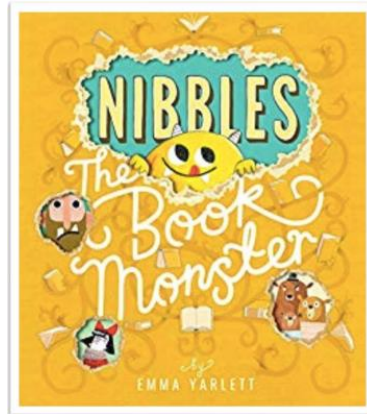
Genre: Recount - Diary entry
