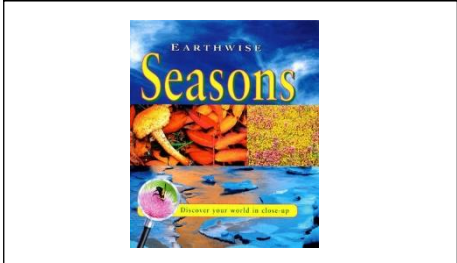
Subject Specific Vocabulary:

physical features	Things in our world that have been created by nature.
human features	Things in our world that have been made by humans.
weather	What the sky and air outside are like, such as cold and cloudy.
season	Spring, summer, autumn and winter.

Key knowledge:

- ❖ Key physical features: hill, mountain, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season.
- ❖ Key human features: park, shop, roads, city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office.
- ❖ A village is a smaller settlement usually found in a rural area. A town is bigger than a village and a city is bigger than a town.
- ❖ The vegetation in a park is a physical feature. Paths and playground equipment within a park are human features.
