Subject Specific Vocabulary

research	The study of materials to establish facts or new conclusions.
evidence	The information that indicates whether a belief is true or valid.
artefacts	An object made by a human being (such as tools or ornaments)
bias	Unfairly against or for one person or group.
civilisation	The society, culture and way of life of a particular area.
archaeologist	A person who studies human history and prehistory through excavation.

Key knowledge:

- Humans in the Stone age hunted large animals, used stone tools to hunt and cut and wore clothes made from the skin of animals.
- Humans in the Bronze Age were mining metals and using this material to make tools. They would travel in boats and wore tunics woven using wool of hemp.
- In the Iron age, tribes fought with deadly iron weapons. Many lived in hill forts to stay safe. Iron Age people ate crops like wheat, barley, peas, flax, beans. They also ate meat like cattle, sheep and pigs.
