Subject Specific Vocabulary

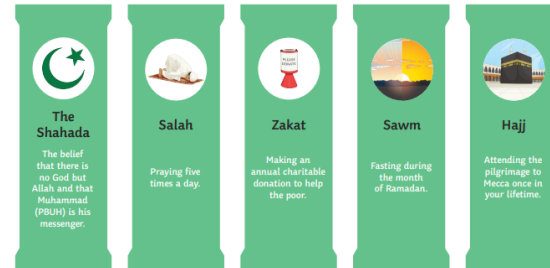
role model	A person looked to by others as an example to be imitated.
wisdom	The quality of having experience, knowledge, and good judgement; the quality of being wise.
guidance	Advice or information aimed at resolving a problem or difficulty, especially as given by someone in authority.
Zakat	A payment made annually under Islamic law on certain kinds of property and use for charitable and religious purposes; one of the Five Pillars of Islam.
Muslim	A follower of the religion of Islam.
prophet	Prophets in Islam are individuals who are believed to spread God's message on Earth and to serve as models of ideal human behaviour.
values	Basic and fundamental beliefs that guide or motivate attitudes or actions. They help us to determine what is important to us.

Key Knowledge:

Prophet Muhammad taught his followers the importance of helping those in need. Prophet Muhammad believed every life should be treated with the same love and respect.

The Five Pillars of Islam

These are the five most important duties for Muslims.



The Five Pillars of Islam (Shahada, Salah, Sawm, Zakat and Hajj) are five key practices that a Muslim is obligated to fulfil throughout their lifetime.

Zakat is the third pillar of Islam. It is one of the **five most important aspects of Islam**.

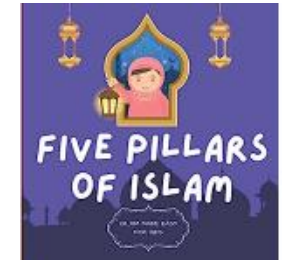
Zakat means giving charity to the poor. Generally, a Muslim is expected to give **Zakat** as long as they are able. Through **Zakat** wealth reaches to the poor people in society.

Muslims carry out Zakat because it is a personal responsibility for them to help those in need.

Prophet Muhammad created rules to look after the poor and it promotes a love of Allah.
