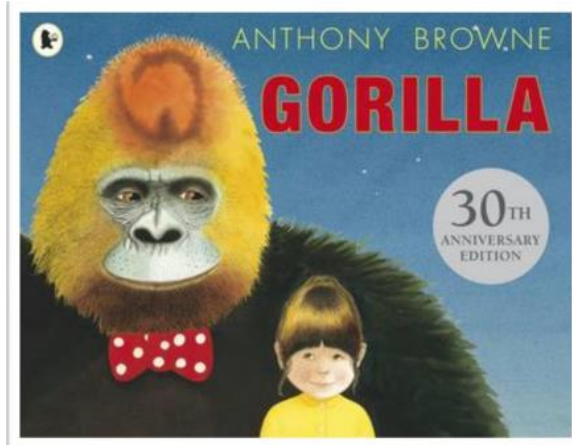


# Year 4 Knowledge Organiser: Gorilla by Anthony Browne

Fronted adverbials: an adverbial word or phrase placed at the beginning of a sentence which are used to describe the action that follows (the verb)

*All night long, she danced.*  
*In June, the event will happen.*  
*Under the clock, he stood and waited.*  
*By the train station, we met.*
