

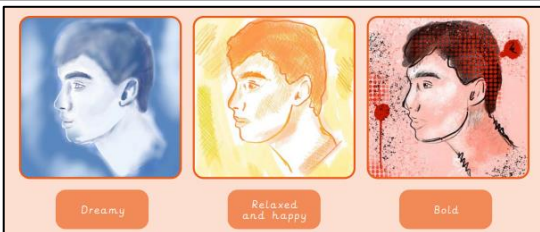
Knowledge Mat: Painting and Mixed Media (Portraits)

Subject Specific Vocabulary

collage	cutting, arranging and sticking materials like paper or fabric to a background
identity	your qualities or beliefs that make you unique
mixed media	art made from a combination of different materials
monoprint	a print that can be made exactly the same way once
multi-media	artwork that includes audio or video elements
photomontage	collage made from photographs
self-portrait	a portrait of the artist, by the artist

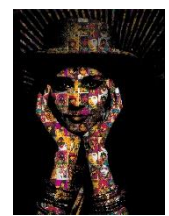
Mixed media artwork uses a combination of materials:
