



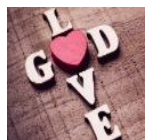

### Subject Specific Vocabulary

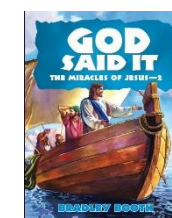
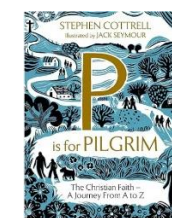
miracle	an exceptional event that demonstrates the power of God
pilgrimage	a journey made to a sacred place as an act of religious devotion
belief	trust, faith, or confidence in someone or something
divine	relating to, or proceeding directly from God or a god
incarnation	the belief that Jesus was fully human and fully divine (God)
annunciation	The announcement to Mary by the Angel Gabrielle that she would give birth to God's son, Jesus.
resurrection	the belief that Jesus came back to life three days after he died on the cross
ascension	forty days after his resurrection, Jesus rose to Heaven

### Key knowledge:

- Christians believe that miracles are 'signs' of the divinity of Jesus.
- Christians believe that Jesus was God incarnate; 'fully human and fully divine' when on Earth.
- Christians learn about the nature of Jesus through his miracles.
- Christians go on pilgrimage to places associated with miraculous events as it brings their beliefs to life.
- Christians believe that the ultimate miracle performed by Jesus was the resurrection - that the ability to rise from the dead three days after being crucified is proof that he was divine as only God has power over life and death.
