| Purchase Reading Eggs (30 licenses) | £1929 | To enable targeted pupils including disadvantaged to catch up reading levels and reading speed to close the gap with peers | KS1 reading outcomes In 2021, 82% achieved EXS+ and 75% disadvantaged achieved EXS+ In 2021, 33% achieved GDS and 25% of disadvantaged achieved GDS |
| 2 iPads to be purchased for KS1 classrooms | £530 | To enable targeted pupils including disadvantaged to receive targeted intervention for Reading Eggs and phonics to close the gap with peers | Y2 Phonics 3 out of the 5 pupils in Y2 who hadn't passed phonics screening test in November 20 passed by July 2021. The 2 children who didn't pass improved their scores from 16 to 30 and 14 to 23. They continue to access Reading Eggs in Y3 and phonics intervention. November 21 Y2 phonics all disadvantaged passed PSC. |
| Spelling Shed | £180.75 | To enable all KS1 and KS2 children including disadvantaged to have further support in catching up spelling | Spelling Shed purchased. |
| Y6 children English booster X14 children x 5 sessions x 30 weeks | £1,209 | To enable targeted pupils including disadvantaged to catch up writing, spelling and handwriting to close the gap with peers | Y6 Writing Outcomes 77% of all pupils achieved EXS+ July 2021 (in line with pre Covid national expectations) and 21% GDS compared to 70% EXS+ in Y5 and 9% GDS in Y5. Disadvantaged 67% achieved EXS compared to 20% in Y5. |

Disadvantaged 50% EXS+ and 13% GDS Writing 71% EXS+ and 23% GDS Disadvantaged 38% EXS and 0% GDS Maths 73% and 25% GDS Disadvantaged |
| Y6 English/mathematics tuition X1 child X1 session per week | £450 | To enable targeted pupils including disadvantaged to close the gap with peers | One child began school with us in September 20 – was currently working at KS1 level in maths achieved 95 SS on Y6 test. |
| Year 4 English/ mathematics booster X3 children X 5 sessions per week | £669.48 | To enable targeted pupils including disadvantaged to close the gap with peers in terms of reading speed, fluency and comprehension and times tables knowledge | One child achieved 91 SS on Y4 maths test (previously pre key stage -80 SS) Two children achieved 96 SS – in line with previous attainment |
| KS1 interventions Member of staff L3 | £13,210 | To enable targeted pupils including disadvantaged to close the gap with peers in phonics, reading and writing skills | All PP children achieved PCS in December 20. 7/8 children . One child missed it by one point after achieving it in a previous test. 75% PP children achieved EXS in reading 2 children who did not achieve had SS of 98 and will be receive extra reading support in Y3. Writing 5/8 did not achieve writing standard and will receive extra writing support in Y3. |
| Reading Plus licenses for targeted children including disadvantaged. 20 extra licenses | £586 | to catch up reading comprehension and reading speed | This booster group is currently running autumn 21 for children who did not access Reading Plus booster sessions last year. |

| 2 iPads Y3 for Reading Eggs and IDL interventions | £530 ordered | To catch up individual children reading speed, fluency and comprehension and fluency in mathematics | Y3 reading outcomes 84% EXS+ Maths 86% EXS+ |
