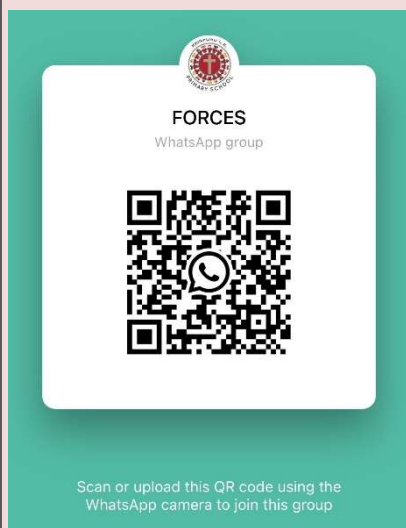

Years 3 and 4 will be attending All Saints Church during week beginning 28th March to look at different stations around the church about Easter – the Easter Experience.

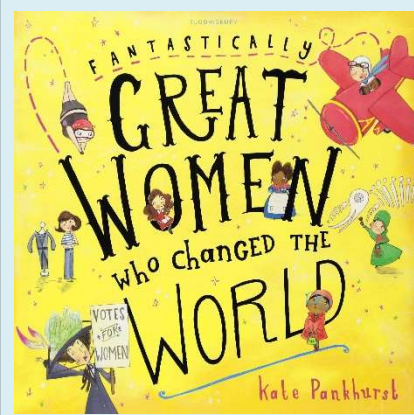
